Visitor Guidelines For The Children's Garden

When visiting The Children's Garden nursery program we would like you to follow the teacher's example with all things. We want you to feel welcome but we also know that it is not always easy to know what to do and when to do and how to do it. Therefore if you observe the teachers and see how they interact with the children and how they carry the children through the morning with rhythm, rhyme and repetition you will be able to move in time with the flow.

If you are accompanying your child and they request a drink or snack please let them know that there will be a snack time during the morning when all the children will have a drink and a snack. If we are on our morning walk and your child decides they want to go home/back/somewhere else, please let them know that we will all be going back to play in the playground.

Some schools encourage visitors to sit in a visitor chair when they are observing the program. We don't require this however we do expect a level of respect for the way we do things at The Children's Garden. We will be happy to address your comments and concerns after the children have gone home.
